Botox Kingston - Skin wrinkles are by definition a ridge, crease or fold in the skin. The wrinkles of the skin often appear as a result of aging, consisting of: the extended immersion of the skin in water or glycation. The wrinkling of the skin is a result of habitual facial expressions, sun damage, aging, smoking, poor hydration and different other factors. Skin wrinkles in the water because of prolonged water exposure which causes the outer layer of skin to absorb water. Depletion of water in the body like with dehydration also can result in the puckering of the skin. Cortisol is another element that causes degradation of skin collagen.

Dermal fillers are normally utilized to be able to remedy wrinkles and other skin depressions. They are injectable products which are usually a kind of soft tissue. Dermal fillers are designed to enable injection into the skin for purposes of enhancing the appearance of the skin. The most well-known products are based on hyaluronic acid.

Botulinum Toxin

The neurotoxin protein, botulinum toxin, is made by the bacterium *Clostridium botulinum*. The most popular type of botulinum toxin is referred to as "Botox," or onabotulinumtoxinA. This specific kind of botulinum toxin is made by Allergan Inc. for both therapeutic and cosmetic use. Botox is utilized in the treatment of migraine headache and spasmodic dystonia or spasmodic torticollis which is a neuromuscular disorder that involves the neck and head. Botox has numerous uses along with its cosmetic application.

During 2009, American people now had a new accessible form of botulinum toxin. This new type, manufactured by Ipsen, is known as Dysport or abobotulinumtoxinA. It has been given approval by the FDA and is now made use of in order to remedy cervical dystonia and glabellar lines in grown-ups. Botox and Dysport however, are not interchangeable as the molecular structure of the two drugs is different.

The Botulinum toxin is able to treat lots of wrinkles by immobilizing or relaxing the muscles that lead to wrinkles. This toxin is not suitable for the remedy of all wrinkles, as is seen with glabellar lines, that occur between the eyebrows in adults. Whatever other usage of this toxin is considered "off-label" use and is not approved by the FDA.
